

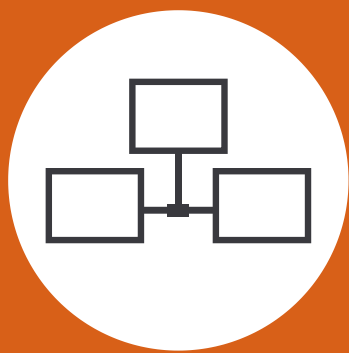
DATA QUALITY MATTERS
